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## 1. Rules and Guidelines

This section describes the general rules and guidelines applicable to all levels of Bible Kalotsavam, Parish/Mission/Proposed Mission, Regional and Eparchial Levels.

All participants and coordinators must read this document carefully and strictly adhere to it.

#### 1.1. General Rules

- 1.1.1. Competitions are to be first conducted at the unit level (Parish/Mission/Proposed Mission), where possible.
- 1.1.2. Entries to the regional competition must be selected from the unit-level competitions, where possible.
- 1.1.3. The Regional Coordinators can decide on the number of participants from unit-level competitions who can participate in regional competitions.
- 1.1.4. Each contestant can only participate in a maximum of 3 individual items and 3 group items, <u>including</u> the 'All' category.
- 1.1.5. The 'All' category is open to all age groups, i.e., it can be a mix of ages.
- 1.1.6. Number of Participants from Regional Levels to Eparchial Level
  - a. Solo Items: Best one winner from the regional level.
  - b. Group Items: Best one winner from the regional level

(quick glance in Appendix 1: Registration, payment and consent forms (Overview))

- 1.1.7. CSMEGB Bible Apostolate Commission will not be responsible for any copyright violation or plagiarism by participants.
- 1.1.8. The decisions of the CSMEGB Commission for Bible Apostolate are final. For the seamless execution of the Kalotsavam, the CSMEGB Commission for Bible Apostolate reserves the right to implement any necessary changes in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

#### 1.2. Bible Version

- 1.2.1. Only the following Bible versions can be used for the Bible Kalotsavam:
  - a. English: The New Revised Standard Version, Catholic Edition (NRSVCE).
  - b. Malayalam: POC Bible

#### 1.3. Age Categorisation

1.3.1. Age groups are divided as follows (amended in 2025):

The cut-off date for determining the age year group is <u>31-AUG-2025</u>, regardless of the competition date. If the unit level or regional level competitions are conducted before <u>31-AUG-2025</u>, you must ensure the participants fall within the age group as of <u>31-AUG-2025</u>.

- 1.3.3. The age group of a group-item will be decided based on the age of the oldest participant of the team.
- 1.3.4. If there is an insufficient number of participants in any group item, contestants from a lower age group may take part in the higher age group category to make up the numbers.
- 1.3.5. For each group item (excluding 'All ages'), at least 4 participants or 50% majority must be within the age group category they are registered to contest.
- 1.3.6. If a participant from a lower age group participates in the higher age group, they will not be allowed to contest again in any category of the same item.
- 1.3.7. Proof of age may be requested from the participant if there is a contention.





#### 1.4. <u>Registration</u>

- 1.4.1. To maintain a consistent approach across the Eparchy, all levels of Bible Kalotsavam centres must issue only <u>a</u> Chest Number, which should be used throughout the day at the centre. This Chest Number may only be issued to the participant on the day of the Bible Kalotsavam at the <u>main</u> registration counter.
- 1.4.2. Participants in the 'Up to 7 years', '8-10', '11-13', and '14-17' year categories should be current students or alumni catechesis at any CSMEGB parishes, missions, or proposed missions. For all other age categories (18-24, 25+, All Ages), registration with their respective CSMEGB parishes/missions/proposed missions is mandatory.
- 1.4.3. Participants can be disqualified at any stage of the competition if their Parish/Mission/Proposed Mission Priest-in-charge cannot verify their eligibility as per the rules set by the Bible Apostolate Commission of CSMEGB. Participants are responsible for ensuring they meet the eligibility criteria.
- 1.4.4. To participate in the unit level competitions, the participant must duly fill the registration form and e-mail/hand it to their unit coordinator.
- 1.4.5. In addition, a participant who is a minor must fill in the CASE 4 Parental Consent for an Activity Form. To fill the form, click here → <u>Parental Consent Form</u> or click the link below or copy and paste it in a web browser.

- 1.4.6. To participate in the regional level competitions, the unit coordinator must confirm their participation with the eligible winners and forward the list of confirmed unit winners along with their completed consent forms to their regional coordinator by e-mail.
- 1.4.7. To participate in the Eparchial Bible Kalotsavam, the regional coordinator must confirm with the eligible winners their participation and forward the list of their confirmed regional participants in the provided template, along with their completed consent forms, to biblekalotsavam@csmegb.org. If any participant wishes to withdraw their consent to publish on public platforms, the Eparchial organising committee should be promptly informed in writing.
- 1.4.8. Registration for the Eparchial level competition will be complete only after the regional coordinator has paid the registration fees in full.

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- 1.4.9. To ensure the smooth organisation of events, eligible winners are strongly encouraged to confirm their participation in the Eparchial Bible Kalotsavam and promptly make their payments immediately after the results are announced on the day of their Regional Bible Kalotsavam.
- 1.4.10. The form should contain the group leader and group members' names for group items.
- 1.4.11. The <u>closing date</u> for Eparchial Bible Kalotsavam registration is <u>27-OCT-2025</u>. Entries submitted after this date will not be accepted. Therefore, <u>all regional competitions</u> <u>must be completed by 25-OCT-2025</u>.
- 1.4.12. Regional coordinators will be notified of the confirmation of a participant's entry after 05-NOV-2025.
- 1.4.13. The Eparchial Bible Kalotsavam programme timetable will be published by 09-NOV-2025.

#### 1.4.14. Registration Fees:

- a. Solo (up to 3 items) £10.
- b. Group items (including the 'All' category) £20 per group item.





#### 1.5. <u>Scheduling</u>

- 1.5.1. Please review the item schedule for any timing overlap with another competition you are taking part. We will make every effort to accommodate individual schedule clashes. Even though we strive to accommodate all requests, there may be instances where conflicting schedules arise, necessitating a decision on your part. However, in some cases, it may be possible to participate in both activities if one can be completed quickly. For instance, if you have a 30-minute painting session scheduled from 11:00 to 12:00, and a solo song competition that lasts 5 minutes per song also scheduled during the same timeframe, you may be able to attend both activities if you register at the earliest with the stage manager to participate in both items before the end of the session.
- 1.5.2. The Bible Kalotsavam Body (Eparchial or Regional) will publish an order of performance for participants of each item. Contestants (individuals or groups) are expected to follow this order. Not adhering to the schedule may result in forfeit.
- 1.5.3. For participants involved in multiple items, the Kalotsavam Body (Eparchial or Regional) will provide a suggested order for their participation to minimise disruptions and scheduling conflicts. Participants must adhere to this order. Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of the involvement.
- 1.5.4. Any late appearance for an item will not be accommodated unless the relevant stage manager is notified in advance in case of a conflict with another scheduled item.
- 1.5.5. No special requests will be considered on the day.
- 1.5.6. If there is only one participant for an item/category, the participant will be declared the winner, and the competition will not be held on stage.





#### 1.6. <u>Complaints</u>

- 1.6.1. The Bible Kalotsavam aims to promote the Bible and the Christian faith. Every participant is expected to follow the Christian spirit. It is noted that occasionally, there may be a genuine reason for a complaint. This section explains the complaints procedure.
- 1.6.2. The participants or their parents/guardians are strictly prohibited from directly contacting the judges under any circumstances.
- 1.6.3. No complaints regarding the judgment will be entertained. The decisions made by the judges will be deemed final on the day of the event. Re-performing or seeking re-judgment will not be permitted.
- 1.6.4. Should you suspect a technical fault, such as an error in mark tabulation, or if there are grounds for disqualification, misconduct, or rule violation, you may bring such matters to the attention of the appeals committee. However, please be aware that video or photographic evidence provided by the complainant will not be considered.
- 1.6.5. The decision of the Appeal Committee will be final.
- 1.6.6. Complaints or appeals must be lodged through the Regional Kalotsavam coordinator or acting coordinator within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results. (Amended in 2025)
- 1.6.7. The results will be announced publicly through one of these medium announcements on main stage or other stages, visually displayed, published online. The exact method will depend on the facilities available at the respective Kalotsavam Venue. (Amended in 2025)
- 1.6.8. The fee for filing a complaint/appeal is £25 (cash). After the complaint is officially lodged and the requisite fee is paid, the appeal committee will meticulously review the scores, ensuring accuracy. Subsequently, the complainant will be furnished with their total marks alongside detailed comments from the judges on their performance. The £25 fee will be reimbursed upon a successful appeal. Fees from unsuccessful appeals will contribute to the CSMEGB Bible Kalotsavam organising fund.





#### 1.7. Health & Safety Guidelines

To ensure a safe and enjoyable competition experience, all participants must adhere to the Health & Safety guidelines prepared by the CSMEGB Health & Safety Commission.

- 1.7.1. Personal well-being
  - a. Ensure you are physically fit to participate. If you have any medical conditions, consult a doctor before competing.
  - b. Stay hydrated and take necessary breaks to avoid exhaustion.
  - c. Wear appropriate/comfortable clothing, and appropriate footwear should always be worn.
  - d. A responsible adult (parent, guardian, or teacher) must accompany each child.
- 1.7.2. Emergency procedures
  - a. Familiarise yourself with emergency exits and first aid stations.
  - b. Report any injuries or health concerns to volunteers or stage managers immediately.
- 1.7.3. Equipment & Environment
  - a. Use all equipment appropriately and only in designated areas to prevent accidents.
  - b. Keep competition areas clear of hazards and follow the instructions from the stage managers and volunteers.
  - c. Avoid and clean or report spills; dispose of rubbish in designated bins.
  - d. Always clean after using the changing areas.
- 1.7.4. Conduct and Awareness
  - a. Always follow the instructions of event organisers/volunteers/stage managers.
  - b. Treat fellow participants, event staff, and volunteers respectfully.
  - c. Respect personal space and avoid rough or aggressive behaviour or unsafe actions.
  - d. No bullying, teasing or inappropriate language.
  - e. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in disqualification. Please stay safe and let us make this competition a great experience for everyone! "Respect, Protect and Compete!"





## 2. Rules and Marking Criteria for each item.

This section describes the rules and marking criteria for each competition item. An overview of the competition grid can be found in Appendix 2.

#### 2.1. Bible Reading

ITEM CODES: Bible Reading English - BRE; Bible Reading Malayalam - BRM. **AGE GROUPS:** Up to 7 years, 8-10 years, 11-13 years, and 14-17 years.

- 2.1.1. Bible Reading Rules
  - a. Duration: 2 Minutes. Bell on time.
  - b. 6 out of 150 marks will be deducted up to 30 seconds over the time limit.
  - c. Participants will be disqualified if they exceed 30 seconds over the time limit (Double bell to indicate disqualification). Participants may finish the item.
  - d. The participant must read directly from the Bible (NRSVCE or POC).
  - e. A bookmark is permitted to identify the passages only for age group 'Up to 7 years', and they <u>must bring their own</u> Bible (NRSVCE or POC).
  - f. For the 08-10 age group, a list of three chapters from the Gospels will be provided for preparation. The passage to read from the chapters will be given on the day. No bookmarks are allowed. (Amended in 2025)
  - g. For the 11-13 age group, the participant will be asked to read from the given Gospel.
     The passage to read from the Gospel will be provided on the day. No bookmarks are allowed. (Amended in 2025)
  - h. For the 14-17 age group, the passage and Bible will be given on the stage table.
     No bookmarks are allowed.

#### 2.2.1. Elocution – Rules

- a. Duration: 3 Minutes. Bell on time, except for the 'Adult' category.
- b. For the 'Adults' category, only an Extempore Speech competition in Malayalam will be conducted.
- c. For Malayalam Elocution competition, the contestant must use Malayalam throughout, other languages must only be used while referring to direct quotes or proper nouns (unless the equivalent word in Malayalam exists). (Amended in 2025)
- d. 6 out of 150 marks will be deducted up to 30 seconds over the time limit.
- e. Participants will be disqualified if they exceed 30 seconds over the time limit (Triple bell to indicate disqualification). Participants may finish the item.
- f. For the Adult category, a single warning bell will be given at 2 mins 30 secs and a double final bell at 3 minutes.

- d. 6 out of 150 marks will be deducted up to 3 minutes over the time limit.

  - Group 14-17 years: maximum of 700 words. (Amended in 2025)
  - Group 18-24 years: maximum of 900 words. (Amended in 2025)
  - Group Adults: maximum of 1100 words. (Amended in 2025)
- d. Only A4 lined paper will be provided. Participants should bring all other required materials/equipment (writing board, ruler, pens, pencils, erasers, pencil sharpeners, etc.).
- e. 6 out of 150 marks will be deducted up to 3 minutes over the time limit.
- f. Please do not write the participant's name anywhere on your submission. Only write your chest number.

- d. The act should be based on a Bible story.
- e. Mono act in Malayalam will get two additional points.

- a. Duration: 30 seconds on stage. Bell on time.
- b. 30 seconds is allowed to set up and 20 seconds to clear props, if required.
- c. 6 out of 150 marks will be deducted up to 15 seconds over the time limit.
- d. Participants will be disqualified if they exceed 15 seconds over the time limit (Double bell to indicate disqualification). Participants may finish the item.
- e. Only individual participant is allowed.
- f. The costume should be based on a Bible story or a Christian theme.
- g. Participants can express their character through costume, makeup, facial and bodily expressions.
- h. The participant must not speak or make any sound during the performance.
- i. Props are allowed, but background sound & light effects are not permitted.
- j. Participants from the "Up to 7" category may receive assistance from one helper to set up props on the stage. (Amended in 2025)
- k. For age groups 08-10 and 11-13, only props that the contestant can manage and carry alone are allowed. No external involvement is allowed. External involvement will lead to disqualification. (Amended in 2025)

- e. Karaoke will not be allowed.
- f. Songs sung in Malayalam will get two additional points.
- g. One microphone on the stand may be provided (subject to venue constraints).Handholding of the microphone is not permitted. (Amended in 2025)

- b. Duration: Minimum 3 minutes (amended in 2025) and maximum 5 minutes. Bell on time.
- c. 6 out of 150 marks will be deducted up to 30 seconds over the time limit.
- d. The team will be disqualified if it exceeds 30 seconds over the time limit (Double bell to indicate disqualification). Participants may finish the item.
- e. Only Christian devotional songs will be allowed.
- f. Karaoke will not be allowed.
- g. Songs sung in Malayalam will get two additional points.
- h. 4 microphones on stands will be provided for the group (subject to venue constraints). (Amended in 2025)
- i. Handholding of the microphone is not allowed.

#### 2.10.1. Dance-Solo – Rules

- a. Duration: 5 minutes. Bell on time.
- b. Maximum stage set-up time 1 minute and clearance time 1 minute.


